The Start/Stop/Continue Presentation Format

Instructions:

You and your group, 3-4 classmates, will be presenting to the Tempe Sustainability and Resilience Office here at Tempe High on **Thursday**, **Dec. 7th.**

For this presentation the format will need to include the information below. Using the YPAR Principles of researching and gathering information, you will make these suggestions to the people responsible for your topic areas.

You will be creating this presentation on all of your Student Portfolio Websites but will choose 1 person's website in your group to present to your professional.

The Start/Stop/Continue Presentation Format:

Each of these sections needs to be present and spoken about in your presentation.

"Start:" What should be started? What isn't happening yet, but would help the problem or question?

"Stop:" What should we stop doing? What is not helping the problem or question, or slowing it down?

"Continue:" What should keep going? What is going very well?

"More:"What is already happening, would it be beneficial to have more happen?

"Less:" What is happening, but too much? What should be slowed down?

"What can we do now?:" Through your research, conversations and observations, is there a way that you see you can do something to positively contribute to your topic right now?

Research Expectations:

For each of these areas you will need to be knowledgeable about what the city of Tempe is doing or has attempted to do over the past few years.

You will also be gathering data through your developed observations, Carlos will be helping us develop these skills.
